ATONEMENT - 10th DAY OF THE 7th MONTH

OT:6031 `anah (aw-naw'); a primitive root [possibly rather ident. with OT:6030 through the idea of looking down or browbeating]; to depress literally or figuratively, transitive or intransitive (in various applications, as follows):

KJV - abaseself, afflict (-ionself,), answer [by mistake for OT:6030], chastenself, deal hardly with, defile, exercise, force, gentleness, humble (self), hurt, ravish, sing [by mistake for OT:6030], speak [by mistake for OT:6030], submitself, weaken, in any wise.

This is the day that all sins are forgiven. So what things happened anciently on this day?

- People assembled together to worship God.
- They did no work on this day.
- They afflicted their souls.
- Animals were sacrificed.
- The High Priest made atonement for himself, the tabernacle, the altar & the people.

So what do we physically do today?

- Assemble together to worship God.
- Do no work on this day.
- Afflict our souls.
- Our High Priest makes atonement for our tabernacle, our altar & us.

Definition:

Sir William Blackstone, in his 1765 authoritative legal text, Commentaries on the Laws of England, said this about coverture and the legal rights of married women:

"By marriage, the husband and wife are one person in law: that is, the very being or legal existence of the woman is suspended during the marriage, or at least incorporated and consolidated into that of the husband: under whose wing, protection, and cover, she performs every thing; and is therefore called ... a feme-covert...."
