

DOES SPEAKING HEBREW MAKE YOU HOLY?

There are many times when the people tried to kill Jesus. Not one of them was for pronouncing God's name in Hebrew.

- When Jesus condemned them for their unbelief in Nazerath: (Luke 4:16–30)
- When Jesus healed people on the Sabbath: (Matthew 12:1–14; Mark 2:23–3:6; Luke 6:1–11; John 5:1–16)
- When Jesus said God was His Father: (John 5:17–18)
- When Jesus said He was the I AM: (John 8:48–59)
- When Jesus said He was God's Son (John 10:31–39)
- When Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead (John 11:45–57)
- When Jesus cleansed the temple: (Mark 11:15–18; Luke 19:45–48)
- When Jesus told the priests & Pharisees the kingdom of God would be taken from them and given to another nation (Matthew 21:33–46; Mark 12:1–12; Luke 20:9–19)

NT:2241 Eli (ay-lee') or Eloï (ay-lo'-ee); of Hebrew origin [OT:410 with pronominal suffix]; my God:

NT:2982 lema (leh-mah') or lama (lam-ah'); or lamma (lam-mah'); of Hebrew origin [OT:4100 with prepositional prefix]; lama (i.e. why):

NT:4518 sabachthani (sab-akh-than-ee'); of Aramaic or [OT:7662 with pronominal suffix]; thou hast left me; sabachthani (i.e. shebakthani), a cry of distress:

OT:410 'el (ale); shortened from OT:352; strength; as adjective, mighty; especially the Almighty (but used also of any deity):

In the Old Testament, God is called “Father” 15 times. In the Gospels? 165. Jesus called Him Father 100 times.

Circumlocution ser-kem-lo-kyu-shen

Function: noun

1 : the use of many words to express an idea that could be expressed in few

2 : evasion in speech

In Mat 4:17; 5:3, 10, 19, 20; 7:21; 8:11; 10:7; 11:11, 12; 13:11, 24, 31, 33, 44, 45, 47, 53; 16:19; 18:1, 3, 4, 23; 19:14, 23; 20:1; 22:2; 23:13; 25:1+14 Jesus used circumlocutions, not a Sacred Name.

- Abraham, Isaac and Jacob knew God as El Shaddai not YHVH. (Exo 6:2)
- Respect, I did not call my father Gary, I am not his equal.
- The Hebrew for shem (name) does not mean the same thing as the English word “name”.
- We are instructed by Jesus to address our Heavenly father as abba/father/daddy.
- It is because of our actions that we have salvation, not because of how we pronounce a Hebrew word.
