Blasphemy

Mat 6:9

Exo 20:7

OT:7723 shav' (shawv); or shav (shav); from the same as OT:7722 in the sense of desolating; evil (as destructive), literally (ruin) or morally (especially guile); figuratively idolatry (as false, subjective), uselessness (as deceptive, objective; also adverbially, in vain):

KJV - false (-ly), lie, lying, vain, vanity.

OT:7723 shav' or shav — emptiness, vanity, falsehood

OT:2490 chalal (khaw-lal'); a primitive root [compare OT:2470]; properly, to bore, i.e. (by implication) to wound, to dissolve; figuratively, to profane (a person, place or thing), to break (one's word), to begin (as if by an "opening wedge"); denom. (from OT:2485) to play (the flute):

 - 2) to be polluted, to be defiled

 - 3) to violate (a covenant)
 - 4) to treat as common
- c) (Pual) to profane (name of God)
- d) (Hiphil)
 - 1) to let be profaned
 - 2) to begin
- e) (Hophal) to be begun

OT:5344 naqab (naw-kab'); a primitive root; to puncture, literally (to perforate, with more or less violence) or figuratively (to specify, designate, libel):

KJV - appoint, blaspheme, bore, curse, express, with holes, name, pierce, strike through.

OT:7043 qalal (kaw-lal'); a primitive root; to be (causatively, make) light, literally (swift, small, sharp, etc.) or figuratively (easy, trifling, vile, etc.):

KJV - abate, make bright, bring into contempt, (ac-) curse, despise, (be) ease (-y, -ier), (be a,

make, make somewhat, move, seem a, set) light (-en, -er, -ly, -ly afflict, -ly esteem, thing), slight [-ly], be swift (-er), (be, be more, make, re-) vile, whet.
