SABBATH

In the KJV Bible in the OT Sabbath appears 172 X's. 137 = Sabbath, 35 = Sabbaths. In the NT it appears 68 X's. There are hundreds of references talking about it.

OT:2142 zakar (zaw-kar'); a primitive root; properly, to mark (so as to be recognized), i.e. to remember; by implication, to mention; also (as denominative from OT:2145) to be male:

OT:8104 shamar (shaw-mar'); a primitive root; properly, to hedge about (as with thorns), i.e. guard; generally, to protect, attend to, etc.:
